- VFS is transitioning to electric over the next 10 years.
- ICF study to be completed in December 2023.
- The City owns and operates 52 EV vehicle with 32 behind the face and public facing EV chargers.
- Raleigh aims to reduce greenhouse gas emissions by 80% by 2050
- Transition to renewable propane and other alterative fuels.
